



VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTION

Title: MCCT Delta Segment Coordinator

Description: The Segment Coordinator will be the point of contact for Delta Segment volunteers, agencies, landowners and organizations in order to coordinate the MCCT effort for the Delta Segment. Must be willing to attend meetings and report to the MCCTC board. Recruits volunteers to take on tasks such as: creating a trail proposal; identifying and evaluating potential trail alignments within the corridor; developing public relations and education strategies to cultivate supporters; estimate cost of trail development and management; identify and manage financial resources; consider user safety, sensitivity of any ecological, historical, or cultural sites and other related issues as needed. This position is under the direction of the MCCTC Board.

Desired Qualifications: Candidates must be interested in trails in general and MCCT in particular; able to work independently and as part of a team and willingness to interact with a diverse group of individuals. They should also possess the ability to communicate clearly, work effectively, while employing tact and sound judgment, in order to maintain and nurture relationships.

Additional Information: The Mokelumne Coast to Crest Trail Council (MCCTC) is a committee made up of board members, officers, trail segment representatives, and agency representatives.
